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### **SEDS 2017 University Student Rocketry Challenge Final Launch Report Deliverables and Guidelines**

The following document has been provided to give an overview of the deliverables guidelines for the Final Launch report to be submitted as part of the 2017 University Student Rocketry Challenge.

Final launch reports should include the following: (Be mindful of the competition rules document)

1. Overview of flight(s) – describe the launch process and the flight details.
  - Include required reusability/altitude verification process
2. Results Analysis – Present an analysis of the flight data and how it compares to simulations and expectations.
  - Include altitude from the provided altimeter, staging outcome, and recovery outcome.
3. Failure analysis, if applicable – what caused the failure(s) and how could they be corrected?
4. Conclusions and future recommendations – what was learned?
5. Multimedia Documentation- Attach videos to submission email or provide a YouTube link.
  - Onboard and ground photos/videos.

Final Launch reports should be professional and sufficient to describe the launch, recovery, and outcome of your team's rocket.
